Inc. offers a fun, challenging, and rewarding opportunity for youth to serve as VolunTeens (Volunteer + Teenagers) at Camp Cool Environment, located in youth recreation facility in the lower lever of the Reformed Church of Highland Park, NJ, 19 South 2nd Avenue. Volunteens work with camp directors, adult volunteers, and other volunteens to create a safe, fun, and exciting time for campers, while discovering the value of working as a community volunteer.

Please note: This is not a paid position.

Volunteen Description

- Serve as a mentor to children ages 8-11.
- Engage in activities with campers such as playing games, doing art, and helping with projects.
- Assist camp directors with daily tasks such as snack preparation and maintaining facility cleanliness.
- Oversee campers on field trips.
- Care for camp equipment and supplies.

Volunteen Requirements

- Rising 8th graders through rising college freshmen.
- Commitment to attend each day of camp on the week assigned and for the full length of time, arriving promptly by 8:30am and leaving at 4:30pm each day.
- Turn off cell phone and all electronic devices during camp hours.
- Attend training session in June, date to be determined.

Volunteen Oualifications

- Behave with kindness, respect, and compassion for yourself and others.
- Possess a sincere enjoyment of working with younger children entering 3rd-6th grade.
- Demonstrate leadership skills when working with younger children, understanding of their needs and putting their comfort and safety first.
- Responsible to complete assigned tasks, trustworthy, and able to work as a team member in cooperation with the other camp staff.
- Be in good health and positive spirit.

Steps to Becoming a Volunteen

- 1. Complete and return the attached application by deadline of April 18th. However, the sooner you return your application, the more likely you are to get your first choice of week(s).
